Feedback on College Infrastructure

A Feedback was taken by the IQAC from students about the college infrastructure. Presented here are some findings of the feedback taken. The responses have been recorded as SD-Strongly disagree, D-Disagree, N-Neutral, A-Agree, SA-Strongly Agree.




Fig 1: Students feedback on classrooms

Figure 1 shows that 46% and 48 % students are strongly agree & agree respectively that classrooms are clean and well maintained. About 4% students are neutral & 2% students are disagree.




Fig 2: Students feedback on availability of adequate number of classrooms

Figure 2 depicts that how students perceived about availability of adequate number of classrooms in the college. Around 37% and 50% were strongly agreed and agreed, respectively about this aspect but 13% students are neutral.




Fig 3: Students feedback on number of laboratories available.




Fig 4: Students feedback on equipment in the labs is in working condition




Fig 5: Students feedback on the seating capacity in the library is satisfactory




Fig6: Students feedback on the prescribed books/reading materials is available in the library/department




Fig 7: Students feedback on the library staff




Fig 8: Photocopying facility in the library is satisfactory




Fig 9: Students feedback on online educational resources are available and accessible




Fig 10: Students feedback on Internet facilities is available in college




Fig 11: Students feedback on the college website is updated and results and attendance records are displayed on time




Fig 12: Toilets are hygienic and properly maintained.





Fig 13: Students feedback on clean drinking water is available on campus.




Fig 15: Students feedback on Overall environment in college is conducive to learning
