If the Parties later agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each party's contributions, deliverables.

- Collaboration in awareness campaigns and other field of mutual interest.
- Engage students and scholars in internship programs
- Provide free of cost mutual access to facilities available for purpose of Awareness Programs. This MOU is signed between National Social Organisation and Govt. Women College for the Academic year 2022-23 for the following deliverables.

Deliverables from the National Social Organisation

1. Collaborate in organizing activities related to Social Activities.
2. Providing platform to our students to undergo short projects and internship programs under National Social Organisation.
3. Organizing various Seminars, health checkup and Blood donation camp and providing education to slum area children.
4. Help college to promote Sustainable Development Practices

Deliverables from the college

1. The College will allow N.S.O to set up stalls for promotion and creating awareness among students about the initiatives of N.S.O
2. Motivate students to undergo various campaign and training program organized by N.S.O.
3. Logo on all online and offline modes of promotion of the event jointly organized by the college and N.S.O.

MODE OF OPERATION

Both parties will provide necessary support for effective implementation of the MOU within the institutional rules and procedures.

This MOU shall be effective from the date it is signed by both the parties.

Within the broad frame work of the MOU, NGO for attaining youth of nation National Social Organisation and Govt. Women College, Hisar can work on awareness activities, internship programs, development of facilities etc.

Any financial commitment for joint activities under this MOU shall be subject to the approval by the Competent Authorities of the respective organizations.

The activities under this MOU shall be coordinated, monitored and recorded by an Internal Coordination Committee. General Secretary, NSO, shall be the internal coordinator from NGO forAttaining youth of nation (N.S.O) whereas NSS Incharge, College will be the internalcoordinator from Govt. Women College. The visitors will be bound by the rules and regulations, as well as the code of conduct of the host institution.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This MOU places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either party. These activities will be defined through separate programs agreements, detailing the commitment of resources (financial or otherwise) required from each institution. Subsequent programs agreements must be approved in advance in writing by the authorized representatives from both Parties. Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connection with all matters relating to collaborations under this MOU. Where possible and appropriate, the parties may also seek funding for collaborations from Government and related agencies.


This MOU is also on broad based understanding between the parties and does not place any financial liabilities on any of the parties. In case there is joint financial involvement between both the parties for any awareness activities it would be decided on event basis in advance.

VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of One year's commencing from effective date.
